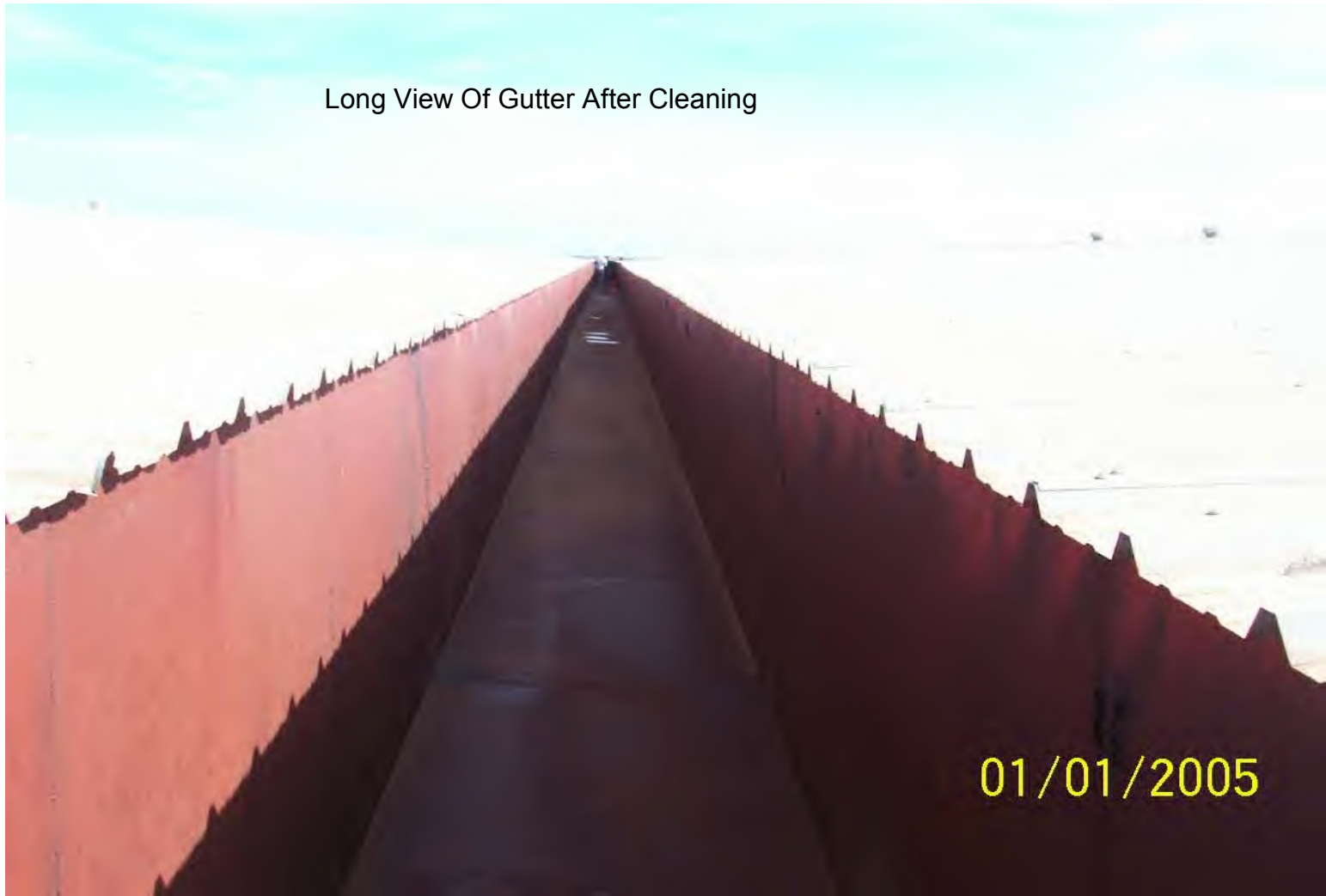

Note Step-Ladder Height Versus Wall Of Gutter

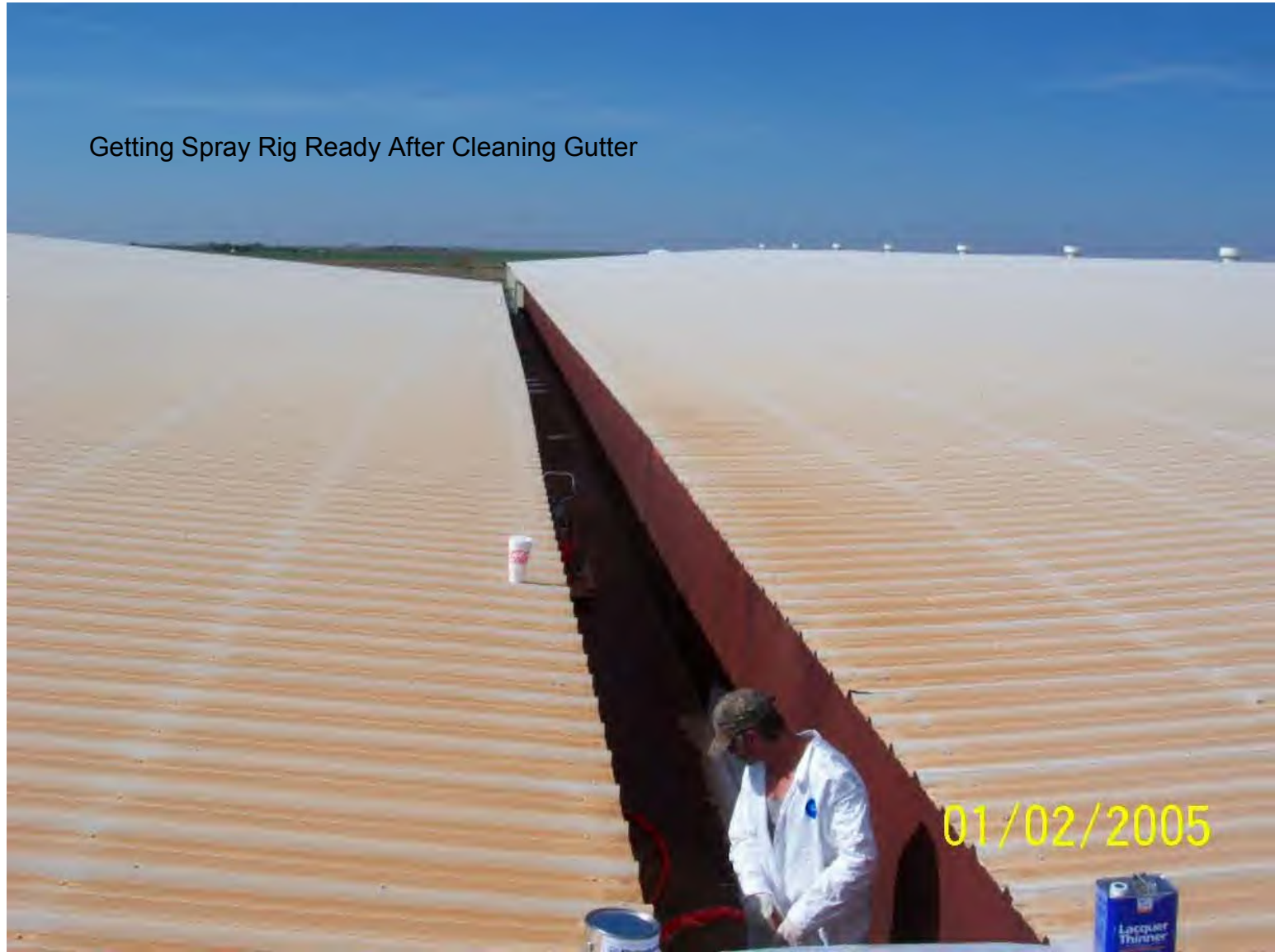


Long View Of Gutter After Cleaning
